Mohammad recounts Zayed's vision for UAE's development

VICE-PRESIDENT HONOURED AS CULTURAL PERSONALITY OF THE YEAR AT ZAYED BOOK AWARD

is Highness Shalkh Mohammad Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai, was honoured with the Cultural Personality of the Year award at the Shalkh Zayed Book Awards ceremony in Abu Dhabi yesterday. The Cultural Personality of the Year category is considered the most significant of the Shaikh Zayed Book Awards. Shalkh Mohammad was honoured in recognition of his work and initiatives to promote culture, as well as many social causes. His Highness Shalkh Mohammad Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi and Deputy Supreme Commander of the UIE Armed Errose, pre-

crown Prince of Abu Dhabi and Deputy Supreme Commander of the UAE Armed Forces, pre-sented the award to Shaikh Mo-hammad. Accepting the award, delivered a speech recounting how the union was formed and established thanks to the com-mitment of Shaikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan. He said: "I would like to tell you a story about the found-ers [of the UAE]. I knew Zayed before the establishment of the union. As you know there were


before the establishment of the union. As you know there were nine emirates and he visited all of them. One day, [Shaikh] Zayed and [Shaikh] Rashid [Shaikh Mohammad's father] met in a small tent and sat on the floor with some cushions. They prayed together and had lunch. I had the honour of serv-ing them coffee. ing them coffee ... The chal-lenges at the time were very big; they were related to the fact that the Arab people did not establish unions and some foreign countries did not want unions to be established.

"The persistence of [Shaikh] Zayed and his wisdom, along with [Shaikh] Rashid, made the union possible... He used to meet with students, teachers, everyone. When he moved, everyone moved. [Shaikh] Zayed wasn't one among us, he was the nation in one man. I can say now Zayed, your children are now global and they have reached out to the world."

Among the award-winners this year was Palestinian writer Osama Alaysa, whose novel Majaneed Bait Lahem (The Fools of Bethlehem) won in the best literature award category, Alaysa's novel narrates the history and changes that took place in and changes that took place in Bethlehem. The novel utilises a

traditional narrative form simi-lar to that of the Arabian Nights, and also employs modern nar-rative writing techniques in telling its story, with a wealth of characters and stories.

Translation category was Japanese researcher Hanawa Haruo
for his immense work in translating Naguib Mahfouz's Cairo
trilogy into Japanese. Published by Kokusho Kankokai, Mahfouz's Cairo Trilogy goes through the social history and changes Egypt went through from 1920 to 1950, with Haruo's

from 1920 to 1950, with Haruo's translation offering a unique opportunity to understand and appreciate Arab culture and history by a Japanese audience. The winner in the Arab Culture in Other Languages category was another Japanese author and researcher, Sugita Hideaki, for Arabian-Nights and the Japanese) book. Published by Iwanami Shoten, the book looks at how the Arabian Nights influenced aspects of modern Japanese culture, such as Japanese children's literature, Japanese theatre, cinema, and fletion.

The winner in the Publishing and Technology category was the Arab Scientific Publishers in Lebanon. The institution created 30 years ago has been involved in publishing scientific and intellectual work aimed at building knowledge in the Arab world. Among its published works are translated works are translated works are translated and the published works are translated works are translated to the property of the p

in the Arab world. Among its published works are translated writings from other languages into Arabic. The group's material is targeted at all age groups. Four categories were withdrawn from this year's edition of the award, including the Literary and Art Criticism award, the Young Author award, the Contribution to the Development of Nations Award, and the Children's Literature Award, due to the poor quality of nominations in these categories.

Prize money

The prize money for this year's award totals Dh7 million, with the Cultural Personality of the Year award carrying the highest cash prize of Dh1 mil-The winners in the other four

The winners in the other four categories each get Dh750,000. The Shaikh Zayed Book Award has been an annual event since 2007, with the award aiming to honour individuals and institutions that have made significant contributions in literature, culture, and knowledge.

The award also honours non-rab researchers and authors

The award also honours non-harab researchers and authors who promote Arab culture in their own languages. Shaikh Abdullah Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Foreign Minis-ter, and Dr Ali Bin Tamin, secretary-general of the Shai-kh Zayed Book Award, were among the dignifaries present. among the dignitaries present.
